Experience Revival by intentionally looking back to look forward.

The Scriptures commend God's people to remember what God has done (see Psalm 77:11-12 for example). In this resource, we are going to intentionally look back to look forward.

1: Look back to the Gospel

You might think that because you're a follower of Jesus, you don't need to hear the gospel today. Not so! We need to hear the gospel every day: it is by being soaked in its truth over and over again that we are renewed into its truth. 2: Look back on your life

As that video says, "Jesus' eternal life is available now!" We don't live only looking forward to eternity ahead of us: eternity is already creeping into our lives today! Take some time and look back at your life and where God has acted in your life in the last month or two. Grab a journal (or a keyboard) and take a few minutes to write down the answer to this question: Where has God been real in my life lately?

3. Look forward to your present

The God who was active in Jesus and who was active in the month behind you is the same God who is walking with you in your day today! He's with you in every challenging situation and circumstance, and he's working to invite you into the "good works" he has already prepared for you - today! To conclude, take a few minutes in prayer and ask God to open your eyes to the good works he is prepared to meet you in today.
